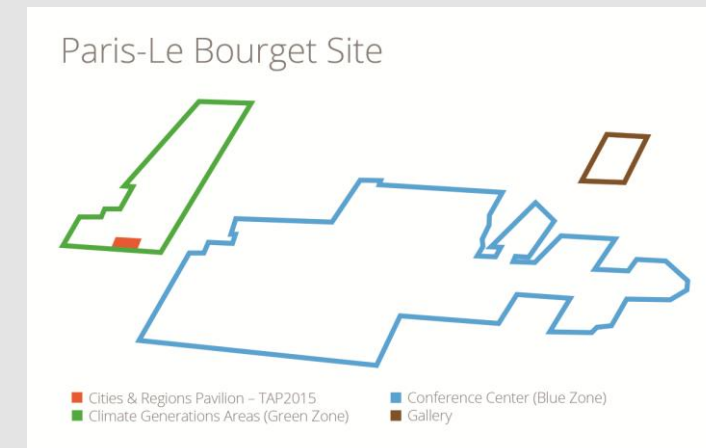
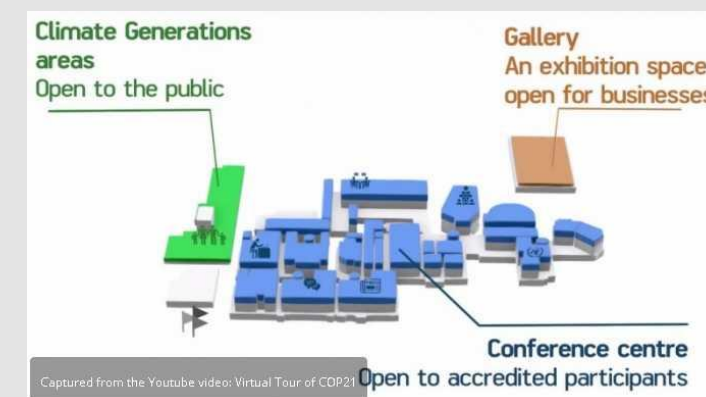
The Cities and Regions Pavilion – TAP 2015

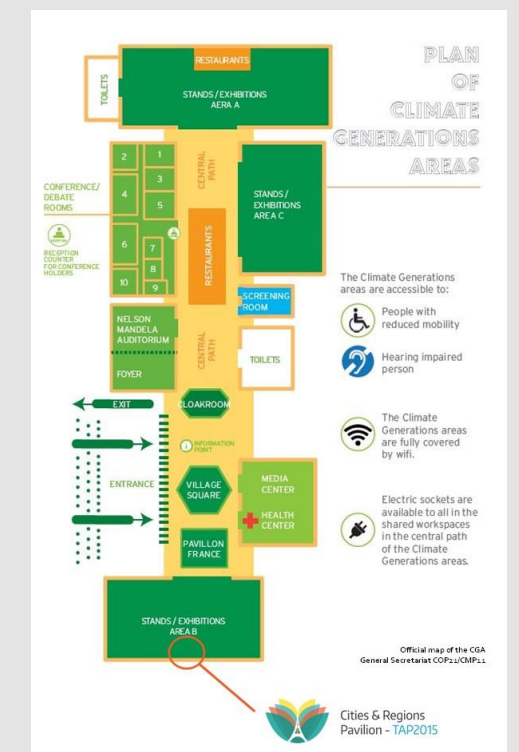
Registration to the Pavilion is highly recommended. Access to the Green Zone is open to all, but additional security measures might be implemented for non-registered visitors.
