# Procurement as a strategic tool

## **Sustainable Public Procurement**

- Decentralized procurement function
- Commitment at the top management level
- Advisory unit for procurement
- Aim:
  - using market power to generate innovation and create markets for more sustainable products and services



# Environmental criteria

## Examples

- Reducing energy consumption in products
- Reducing number of deliveries and eco-driving
- Requiring sustainable materials (certifications)
- Assessing life time and life cycle costs (LCC)
- No use of dangerous chemical substances unless proved necessary (must be documented)
- Reducing and recycling packaging and membership in Green Dot Norway plc. or equivalent
- Only sustainable tropical woods (must be documented)

- Electric passenger cars and mini-vans in own fleet
- Incentives for EV owners
- Charging stations

## Focus areas

- Developing more sustainable mobility solutions
- Reducing greenhouse gas emissions from:
  - deliveries of goods and services
  - public buildings
  - construction sites
- Reducing energy consumption
- Reducing and recycling of waste



# Further developments (2)

## Focus areas

- Encouraging more sustainable consumption and reuse
- Increasing the share of ecological food and beverages to 50%
- Increasing the share of innovative procurement and encouraging development of climate neutral technology and solutions
